The Augusta Regional SPCA would like to wish you and yours a Holiday Season filled with Hope and Joy! Your support is so important to us as we strive to provide positive outreach and a warm and safe environment for the animals in our care.

As the New Year approaches, we would like to share with you – our supporters- a few of the special happenings during 2021.

Thanks to a generous grant from the ASPCA, we were able to purchase and install a stand-by generator for our spay/neuter clinic. This generator provides a safe surgery environment for the animals that come to our clinic for sterilization and provides a stress-free environment for our staff to perform their duties. The security of having this generator to eliminate disruptions during surgeries enhances the quality of service we provide to our community.

The ASPCA Relocation program provides two valuable services to our shelter. They utilize our facility for overnight stays when transporting dogs from overcrowded shelters in the south to shelters in the northern area of the US in need of adoptable animals. We also partner with the ASPCA as a destination shelter for animals to be transferred into our adoption program. The ASPCA has been a valuable partner of the AR SPCA for many years, and we look forward to continuing that partnership for years to come.

Our Pets for Seniors program through the Jack Didawick Adoption Fund has provided multiple seniors the love and joy of adopting a family member from the ARSPCA.

We have just completed 160 spay and neuters for our community at a reduced cost through a generous bequest from our longtime supporter, Maryanne Moffett, through the Community Foundation of the Central Blue Ridge. Thanks to Maryanne's vision, we proudly provide this service to our community.

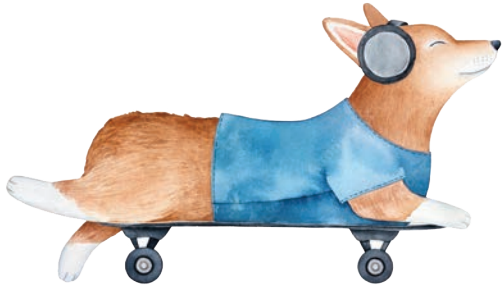
Your generous support keeps hope alive for the special creatures in our care. The enclosed envelope is for your contribution to assure that our furry friends may share their love, hope, and joy!

Saying goodbye to our beloved shelter pet "Lilly"

Lilly arrived at the AR SPCA March 9, 2005, as a stray brought in by Staunton Animal Control found in the Old Greenville Road area.

You could tell by her appearance that she had been fending for herself, but she had ice blue eyes that just sucked you in. She was very underweight, and her coat was thin and dull. It did not take Lilly long to realize that she had the staff in the palm of her paws and everyone's goal was to get her healthy and find her a forever home.

Little did we know, the shelter and staff would end up being her forever home and family! As the process of getting Lilly healthy progressed, the staff decided she needed to be part of the team! Lilly made a trip to the vet to be spayed; however, she gave birth to a litter of black kittens before they could perform the surgery! We brought Lilly and her kittens back to the shelter and once the kittens were old enough to be adopted, we placed them in their new homes, and Lilly became our shelter pet!

Lilly had shared that role with Big Mac and when he passed, she took over the duties of greeting shelter visitors and keeping the staff on their toes. Lilly was truly the ugly duckling that turned into the beautiful swan!

On August 7, 2021, we had to make the hard decision to say good-bye to Lilly. Her health had declined over the years, and we could not let her suffer because we couldn't let her go. The shelter is not the same without her and there is not a day that goes by that someone does not remember Lilly!

Sebastian joined Lilly as our shelter pet in 2017, and even though they were best buddies, Lilly was the queen in charge! Sebastian and staff miss Lilly dearly and we will always cherish her memories.

you will be in our hearts forever.



Shelter & Clinic Updates

The staff at the AR SPCA Shelter and the Agnes Lawrence Spay/Neuter Clinic may be reduced since Covid; but know how to produce positive results!

The shelter staff went from 20 employees to 5 during the Covid pandemic; but their determination to make a difference for animals in need has never faltered. During 2020, shelter staff adopted 723 dogs and cats and 4 guinea pigs to loving families. And through the middle of November 2021, we have had 341 dog and cat adoptions and 4 guinea pigs adopted. Everyone on staff has stepped up and has helped with any task that needs to be completed. We have even had Stacey sweeping, although she is much better with numbers and spreadsheets! Staff dedication to the animals and loyalty to our shelter has gotten us through the effects of Covid-19!

The AR spay/neuter clinic staff is second to none! Under the leadership of Dr. Susan Rieser, we have assembled one of the most amazing and talented teams in the low-cost spay/neuter world. In 2020, the clinic performed 4,262 surgeries and the clinic was closed for 5 weeks due to Covid. By the end of 2021, the clinic will reach over 4,500 surgeries! Of course, the success at the clinic would not be possible without our community support and our local rescue groups utilizing the clinic. The clinic has partnered with 15 rescue groups and SPCAs requesting our services for spaying and neutering. A huge thank you to each of them for working with us to reduce overpopulation. This staff knows how to get the job done!



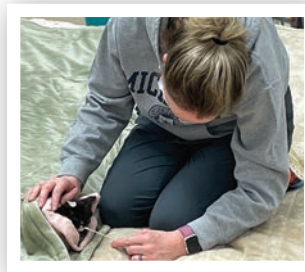

Thank you for all that you do - best wishes for a wonderful 2021!

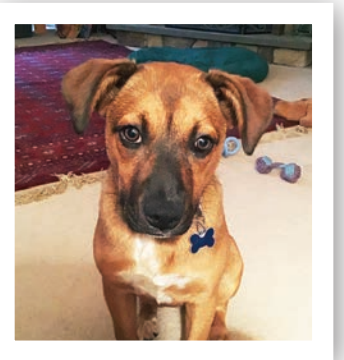


We just wanted to thank you! Jayden is a perfect fit and seems so happy.

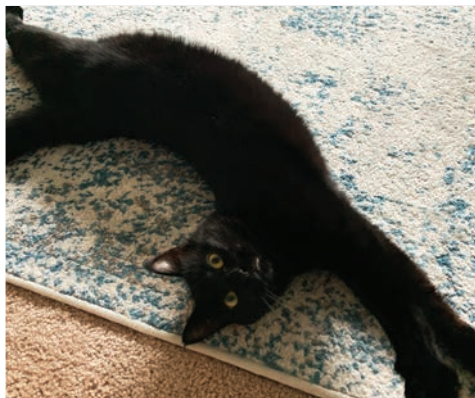

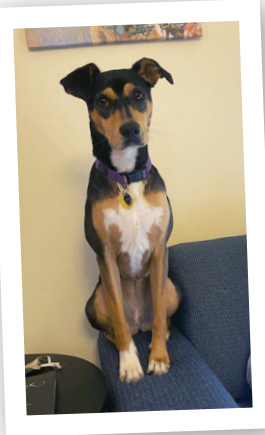


Merry Christmas from your friend and former resident, Roger.

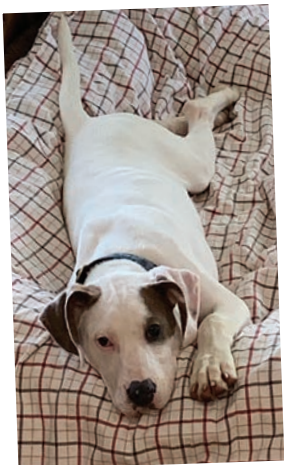

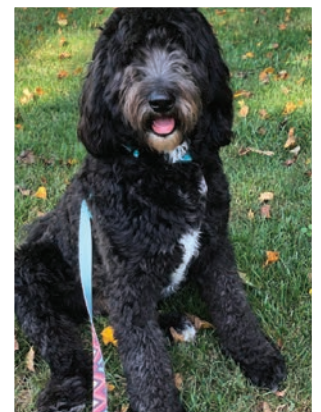
