



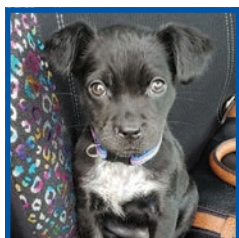

So many changes have transpired over the years since the AR SPCA reverted to operating as a private shelter. Our mission focuses on adoptions and reducing the number of unwanted litters being born in our community.

Our partnership with the ASPCA provides adoptable animals for our adoption program through their Animal Relocation Program and the Nancy Silverman Rescue Ride. Our facility also serves as overnight accommodation for the ASPCA transports from southern states facing overpopulation issues to northern shelters in need of adoptable animals. This partnership is also a valuable resource for grants for shelter improvements and special adoption events. We are proud to be a partner with the ASPCA!

We placed 372 animals in their forever homes during 2022, and the spay/neuter clinic performed 4,598 surgeries last year.

Dr. Susan Rieser is a talented surgeon and amazing leader for our clinic staff. Both our shelter staff and clinic staff are small, but focused on the tasks at hand. There are always challenges when dealing with animals, and every staff member is willing to give 100% to meet the daily needs.

The continued success of the AR SPCA would not be possible without the ongoing support of our community and the partnerships of our rescue groups working together to make a difference.

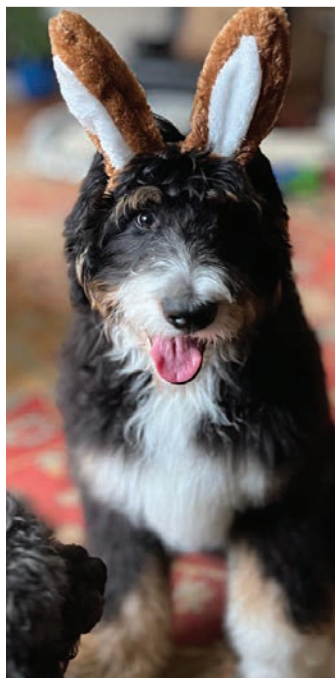

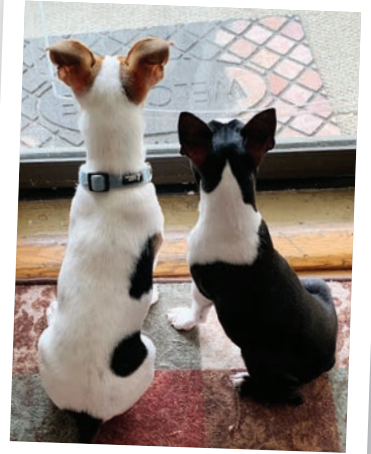

Thank you for all for taking such good care of him until we found him. He's the perfect boy for us and our family

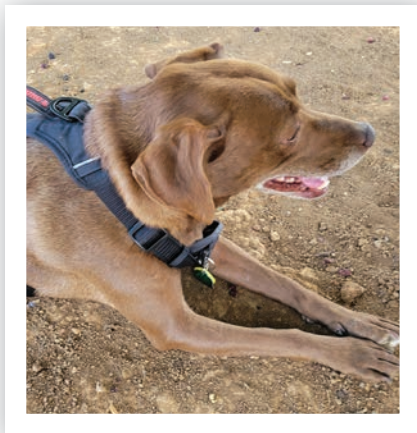

When we're outside, he loves to take walks, and he loves playing with my next door neighbors' two dogs.

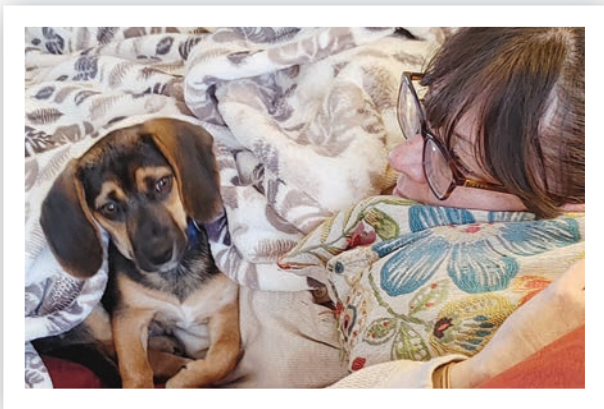


We adopted Jim around April 2022 and he has been an excellent addition to this family!!! As you can see my kids love catching him off guard!!!

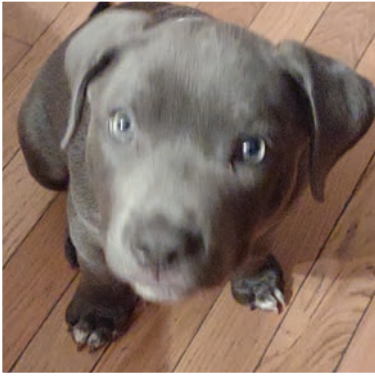

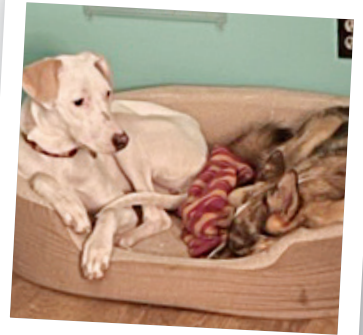

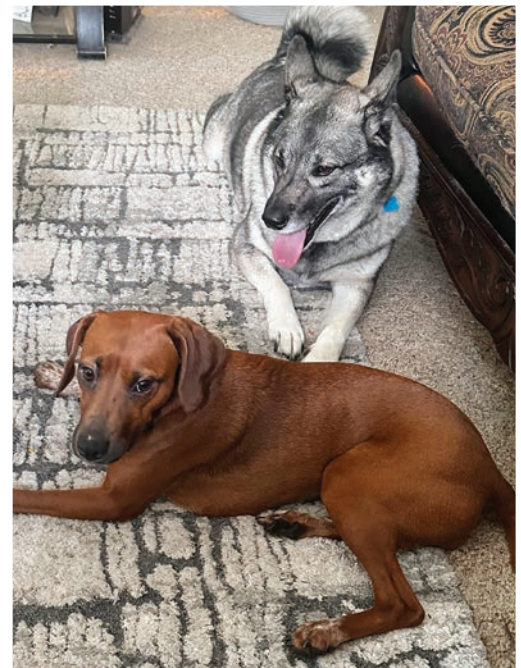
