Wishing you a retirement as amazing as the impact you've made. Thank you for your unwavering commitment and guidance.

After 33 years as Executive Director, Debbie Caywood has announced her retirement at the end of 2024. Debbie came to the ARSPCA in June of 1991 when it was just a bare bones metal building on top of a hill. Through the years, Debbie spearheaded growth that saw the expansion of that metal building to include offices, boardroom, visiting rooms and other much needed space. The Agnes Lawrence Spay/Neuter Clinic was opened in 2011 offering low cost services to the local community.



Prior to Debbie's arrival, fund raising was minimal if not absent. The annual Cause for Paws was started under Debbie's leadership and has grown into the largest fund-raising event the ARSPCA has. Outreach to the local community to raise funds and awareness has grown through the 33 years to where the ARSPCA can offer much more for education and to the animals we serve.

Building relationships with national animal welfare organizations has been key in the success of the ARSPCA, the most impactful being the long term, lifesaving partnership with the ASPCA (American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals). Utilizing our empty shelter space to elevate their work in animal transport through a program involving an overnight stopover, or waystation, for safe transport. This revenue stream and additional grant funding has allowed additional local programs and plans for the shelter to flourish. Pet Smart Charities has also been a supporter of the ARSPCA, thanks to Debbie's dedication and ability to build strong relationships. Reaching out to local rescue groups and shelter partners has been another way that Debbie has grown community outreach and helped our region save more lives together. Our volunteer program is thriving and she expanded our grant program beyond our expectations!

It is hard to list the growth, the awareness and positives that have come in the 33 years Debbie has dedicated her career to leading the ARSPCA. Thousands of animals have been rescued; thousands have been spayed or neutered, and because of her efforts to expand, raise funds, and plan for the next generation of leaders, our mission is being achieved and will continue well into the future.

On behalf of the employees, Board of Directors, Supporters and the thousands of Cats and Dogs that have been rescued, THANK YOU DEBBIE!!!! We all wish you and husband David, a happy and fulfilling retirement.

Shelter & Clinic Updates

Where has the time gone? On June 13th, I celebrated 33 years of employment with the Augusta Regional SPCA. As I am working on the shelter and clinic updates for the Critter Chronicle, I realize the importance of each staff member at the shelter and the clinic. Without loyal, caring and dependable employees, our accomplishments over the years would not have been possible. In the animal welfare field, the longevity of employees is 2 to 4 years. We have certainly blown those statistics out of the water!

The shelter staff is rock solid with Crystal Via, Director of Operations, who has 20+ years of service, Stacey Moran, who has served as our Accounting Specialist for 10 years and Julie Trimble, the best animal caregiver in the business and is going into her 5th year with us. Kylie Panter joined us April 2024 and Emily Dillon joined us June 2024, both are welcomed additions. Our newest employee is Beth Dickerson, hired as the new Executive Director and I hope will be the face of the AR SPCA for many years to come.

I feel like a proud mom when thinking about our spay/neuter clinic staff. It was a goal of mine to have a low-cost clinic on our property to provide affordable surgeries to our community and surrounding areas. It was not always smooth sailing along the way, but the day I met and interviewed Dr. Susan Rieser, I knew there were no limits on what this clinic could accomplish. I am always amazed at her surgery skills, her dedication and her compassion to provide high quality surgeries on the patients in her care. The team surrounding Dr. Rieser is totally amazing and Dr. Rieser has created a work environment to bring out the best work ethic in each employee.

We had 395 animals adopted from the AR SPCA in 2023 and 10 cats transferred to an approved facility through our partnership with the ASPCA. We are very appreciative of the grants provided to us through our partnership with the ASPCA. Their partnership also provides very adoptable dogs for our adoption program, and they utilize our facility overnight to house cats and dogs enroute to their forever homes on the Nancy Silverman Rescue Ride.

The spay/neuter clinic performed 4,878 surgeries during 2023, and for every spay and neuter completed, we are eliminating unwanted litters. We are grateful for the support of our community and rescue groups and shelters that utilize our clinic to help reduce overpopulation. Thanks to the vision of our longtime supporter Mary Anne Moffett, we can provide financial assistance to pet owners in our community through the MAM grant.

Time certainly changes things, but our continued community support will always be the key to our success and enable us to reach our goals of making a difference in animal welfare.



I love, love him and am so grateful that you had him and I found him online! He's a wonderful, silly, sweet dog who loves everyone he meets.










Attached is a picture collage for Borgi. We adopted her 10 years ago from you all, and the miles she has traveled and hearts she has warmed are incalculable.

Thank you for all you do to help pets in need and for matching them to families!






I wanted to send a quick video and a few photos to show you how Burrito is doing in his new home. We absolutely love him. There has been no adjustment time. Our older dog


